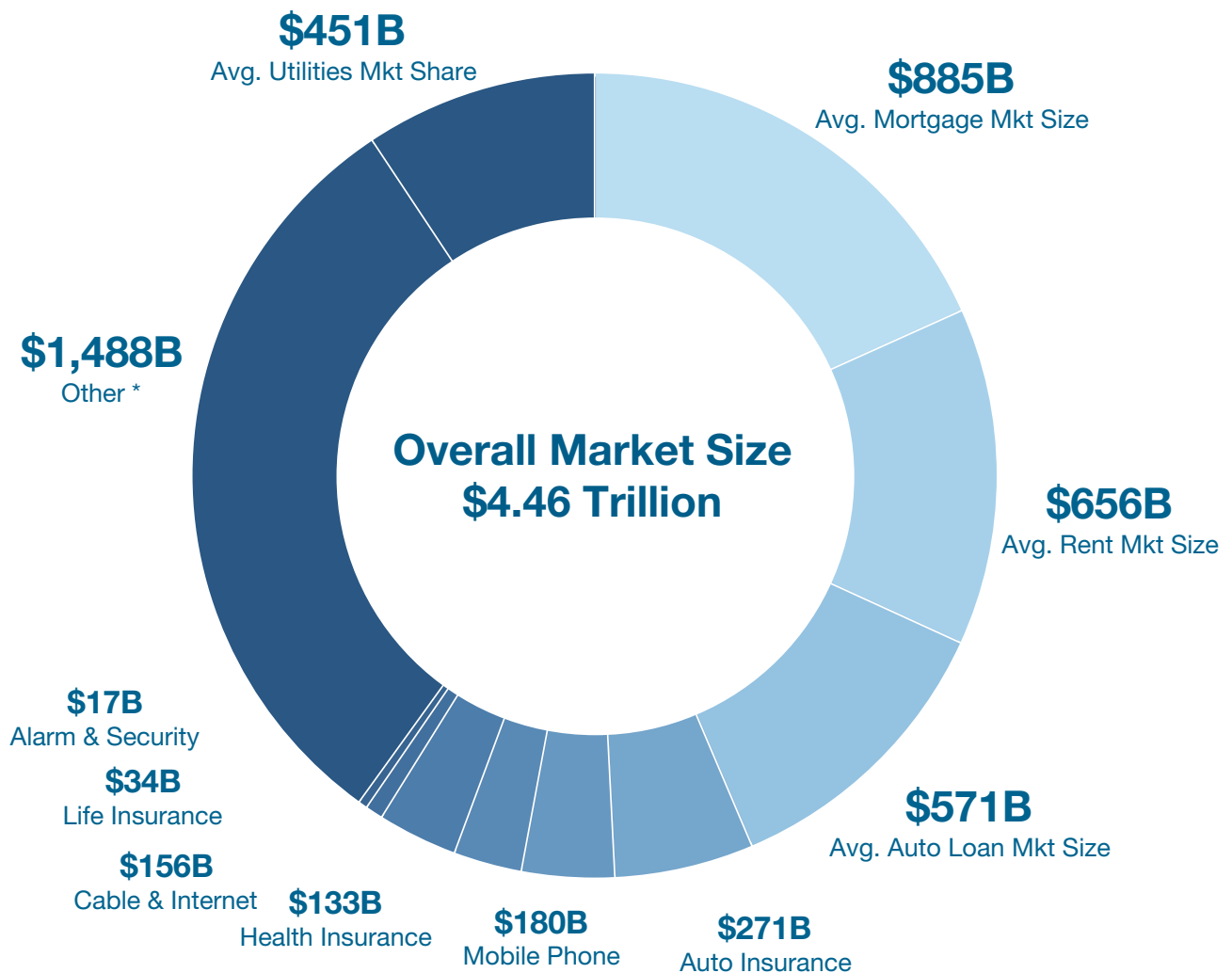

## Overall Bill Pay Market Size (in billions)

While the total market size for U.S. household bills is \$4.46 trillion per year, this report focuses on the ten most common household bills, which amount to \$3.35 trillion. These include Mortgage; Rent; Auto Loan; Utilities (electric, gas, water & sewer, and waste & recycling); Auto Insurance; Cable & Internet & Phone; Health Insurance; Mobile Phone; Alarm & Security; and Life Insurance.






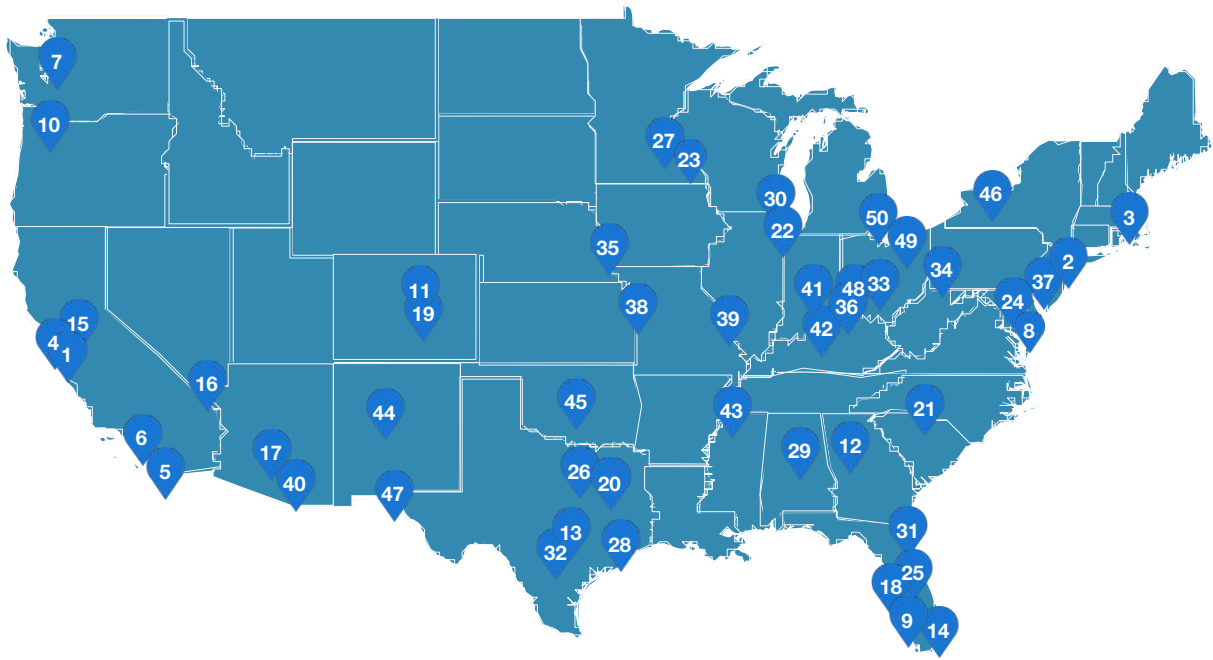

## The 50 Largest U.S. Cities Ranked by Monthly Household Spend

Residents in San Jose, CA spend \$3,695 each month on the ten most common household bills, 74% above the national average. At the other end of the spectrum, households in Detroit, MI spend an average of \$1,640 across the top ten categories, 23% below the average nationwide. 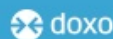
