Overall Bill Pay Market Size (in billions)

While the total market size for U.S. household bills is \$4.55 trillion per year, this report focuses on the thirteen most common household bills, which amount to \$3.45 trillion. These include Mortgage; Rent; Auto Loan; Gas; Electric; Water & Sewer, Waste & Recycling; Auto Insurance; Cable & Internet; Health Insurance; Mobile Phone; Alarm & Security; and Life Insurance.



The 50 Largest U.S. Cities Ranked by Monthly Household Spend

Residents in San Jose, CA spend a median of \$3,523 each month on the 13 most common household bills, 71% above the national median. At the other end of the spectrum, households in Cleveland, OH spend a median of \$1,606 across the top 13 categories, 22% below the national median. The rankings of the largest 50 U.S. cities (based on # of households), in order of most to least expensive, are as follows:


